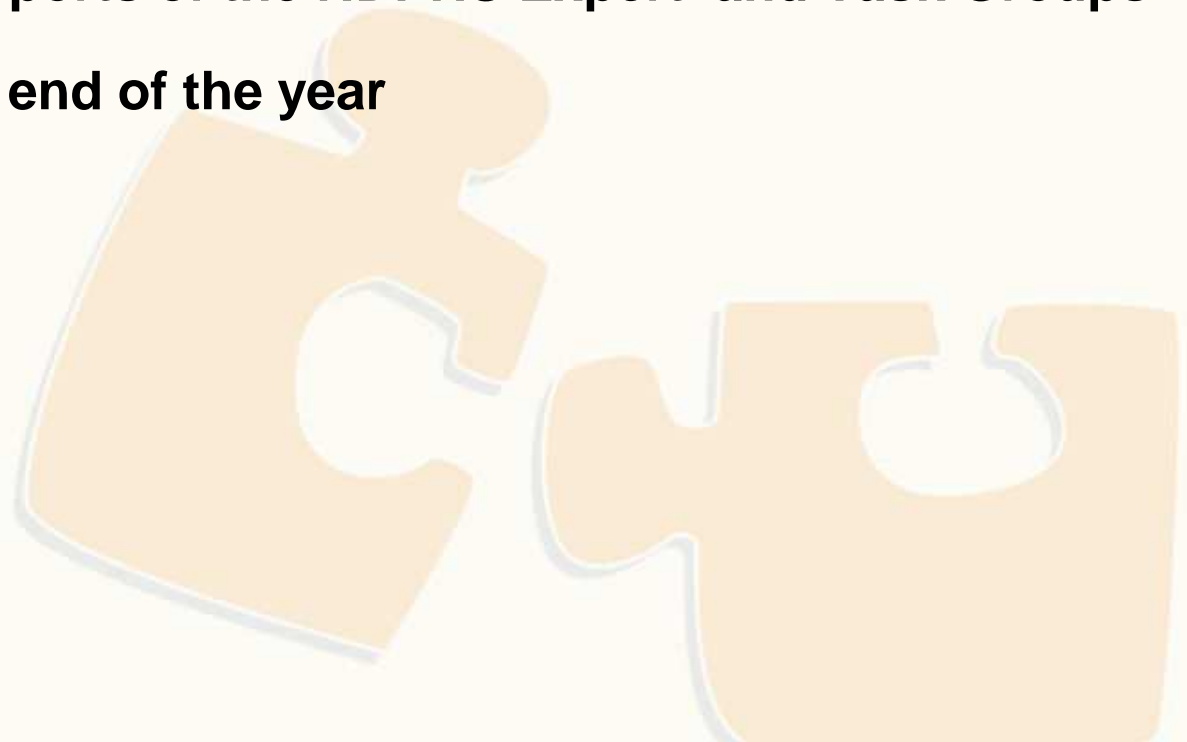

Achievements of the Partnership (1)

Implementation of the NDPHS Strategy


- Successful reform of the NDPHS expert level structures
- Overall, good progress towards achievement of the NDPHS goals and implementation of the operational targets
- A range of actions to increase the visibility and wide recognition of the Partnership
- Eight regional projects under development in 2011


Leadership and coordination of the health priority sub-area in the EUSBSR Action Plan


- Engagement of relevant regional stakeholders in the EUSBSR health-related activities
- Promotion of the EUSBSR health-related flagship projects



Achievements of the Partnership (2)

-  **Providing adequate funding for the NDPHS and its activities**
 - Voluntary contributions from the EU, Germany and Sweden
 - Norwegian funding channelled through the NDPHS Project Pipeline
 - Commencement of cooperation with the Baltic Sea Network of the European Social Fund and the ENPI CBC Karelia Programme
 - Development of the NDPHS position paper on raising the profile of health and social well-being

-  **Establishment of the NDPHS Secretariat with its own legal capacity**
 - Finalization of the Agreement on the Establishment of the NDPHS Secretariat
 - Signature of the Agreement

-  **Monitoring the Partnership's progress and reporting on it**
