Working areas of the EG objective tree

0. **Management** component of the Strategy and Action Plan

EUSBSR

Action: Contain the spread of HIV/AIDS and tuberculosis

Through partnerships and international collaboration in prompt and quality care for all, focusing on tuberculosis/HIV co-infection and ensuring early diagnosis of HIV infections, providing access to treatment and strengthening interventions to reduce vulnerability, especially for Injecting Drug Users (IDU), prisoners, etc.

The NDPHS Expert Group on HIV/AIDS and Associated Infections will plan a comprehensive flagship project on Strengthened prevention and reduction of impacts of HIV, AIDS & AI (TB, hepatitis B & C, syphilis, gonorrhoea) among key populations at risk in the Baltic Sea region.

VISION 2020: The NDPHS, as a highly valued and innovative regional network, significantly contributes to the improvement of peoples' health and social well-being in the ND Area

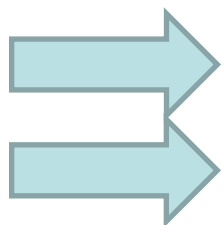
