Items of the Questionnaire (ToR)

- Information on recording of:
 - Occupational diseases
 - Work related diseases
 - Emerging risks
- Type of information:
 - lists of national legally defined occupational diseases
 - criteria for diagnostics and reporting
 - reporting methodology

Required output Questionnaire

- Information on OD, WRD and ER:
 - lists of national legally defined occupational diseases
 - criteria for diagnostics and reporting
 - reporting methodology
- Estimates of work-related diseases
- Denominator information
- Best practices

Items of the Inventory

REVISED DURING THE MEETING

- Legal context, problems
- Registers OD, WRD, ER
- ER: tools for discovery of ER
- Case definitions (OD, WRD, ER) used in the registers: characteristics
 - Lists
 - Criteria
- Reporting methodology
- Reporting behaviour, barriers for reporting, incentives
- Denominator information
- Best practices

Questionnaire process (ToR)

- **Draft Questionnaire**
- **Pretest** in some (3-5) of the participating countries
- **(First) analyses results of draft questionnaire: Corrections** on the basis of first analyses
- **Final questionnaire survey** in all participating countries
- **First round of analysis of replies:** inventory registers and statistics
- **Second round of analysis of replies:** guidelines to develop recommendations and to describe best practices

Proposed steps for drafting Inventory

- 1. Defining required output in detail
- 2. Determination of modules of Inventory
- 3. Drafting questions per module + explanation text (if necessary)
- 4. Introduction
- 5. Lay out
- 6. Pretest
- 7. First analysis of pretested draft Inventory:
 - Does the inventory provide the requested information?
 - Comments of experts: improvements?
- 8. Drafting final Inventory
