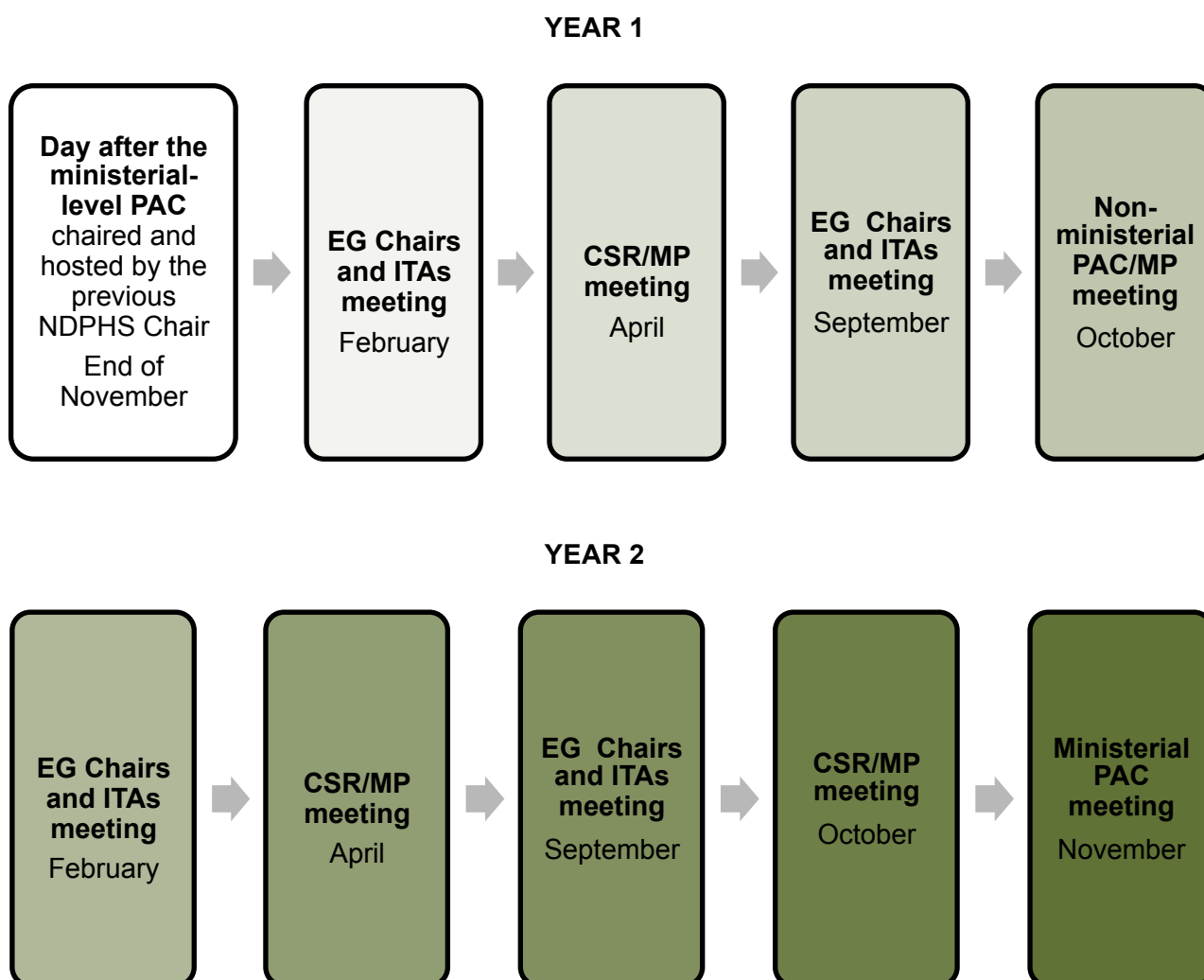

A typical NDPHS Chairmanship cycle looks as follows:



Main responsibilities of the NDPHS Chair:

- Chairs the Partnership and carries forward its work through facilitating processes, seeking solutions and consensus;
- Chairs the PAC, MP and CSR meetings, sets their agendas and supervises the preparatory work;
- Supervises the NDPHS Secretariat's work;
- Represents the Partnership externally;
- Performs various managerial and supervisory tasks as stipulated in the NDPHS Secretariat's Personnel Handbook and Financial Rules.
