TRAVEL INFORMATION

By bus from Tallinn to Tartu

During the day you can find frequent bus lines from Tallinn to Tartu. Travel time is approximately 2,5-3 hours and costs about 10 euros. You can check the timetable and book your ticket on www.tpilet.ee page.

You can find straight bus connection to Tartu at least from Latvia, Lithuania, Poland and Russia.

By train from Tallinn to Tartu

Train to Tartu leaves from Baltijaam station which is located next to Tallinn old city. Trains operate from 6 am to 8 pm and travel time is approximately 2.5 hours and tickets costs about 10-12 euros. You can check timetable and prices on www.elron.ee page.

Straight train connection can be found also from St. Petersburg and Latvia to Tartu.
