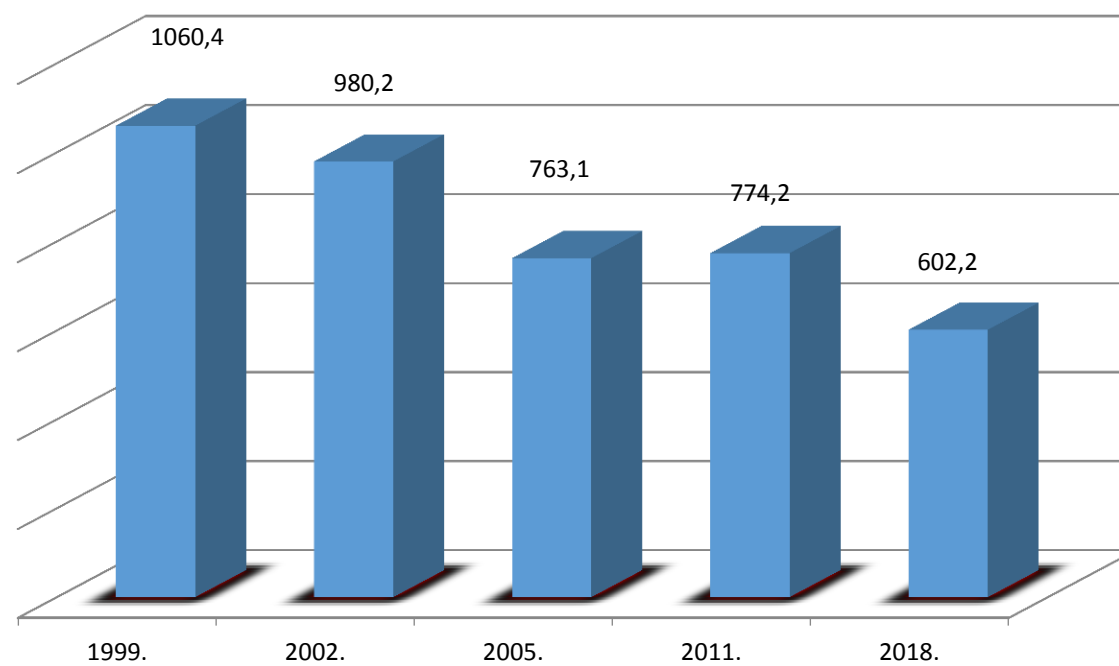

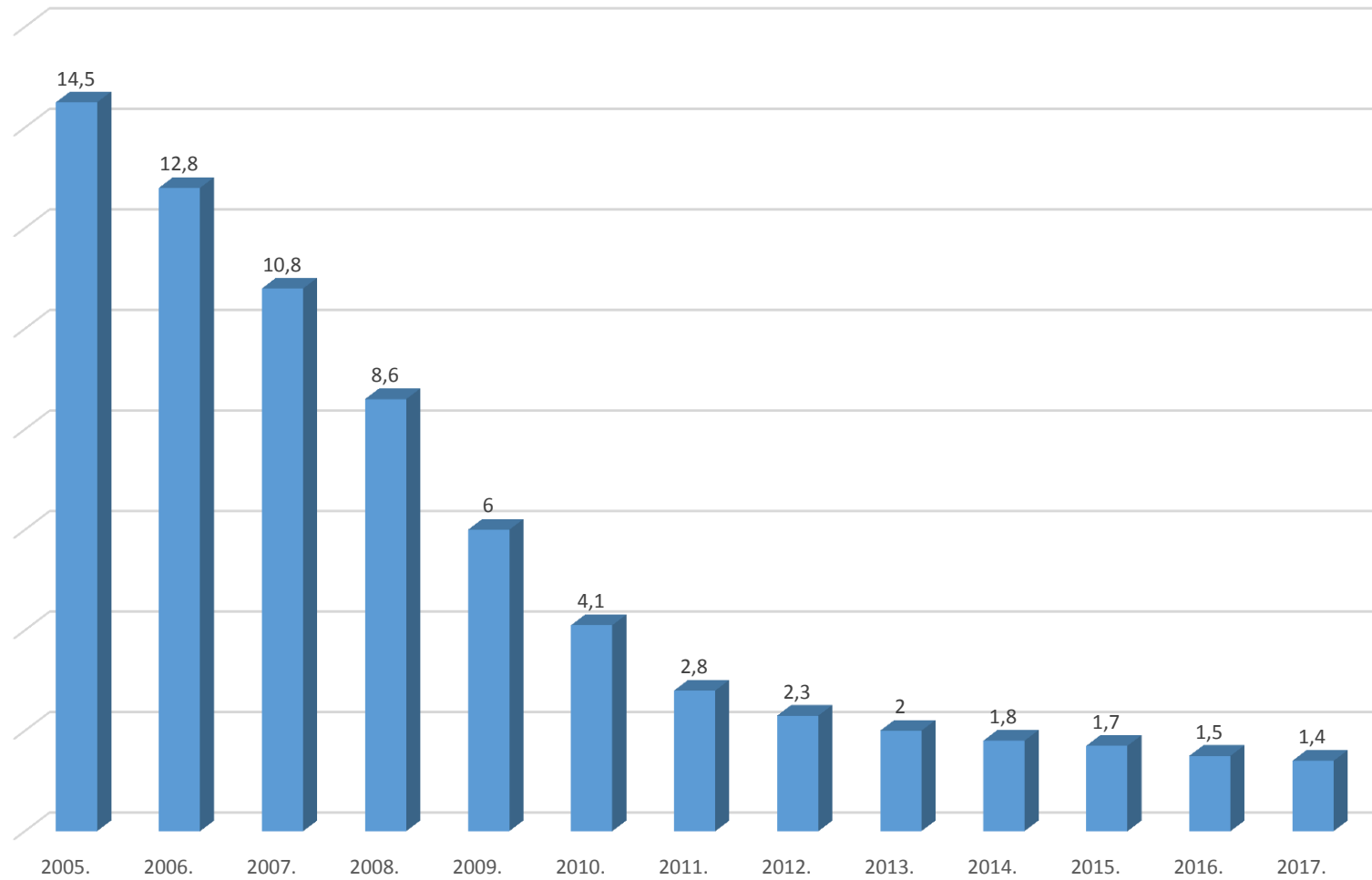

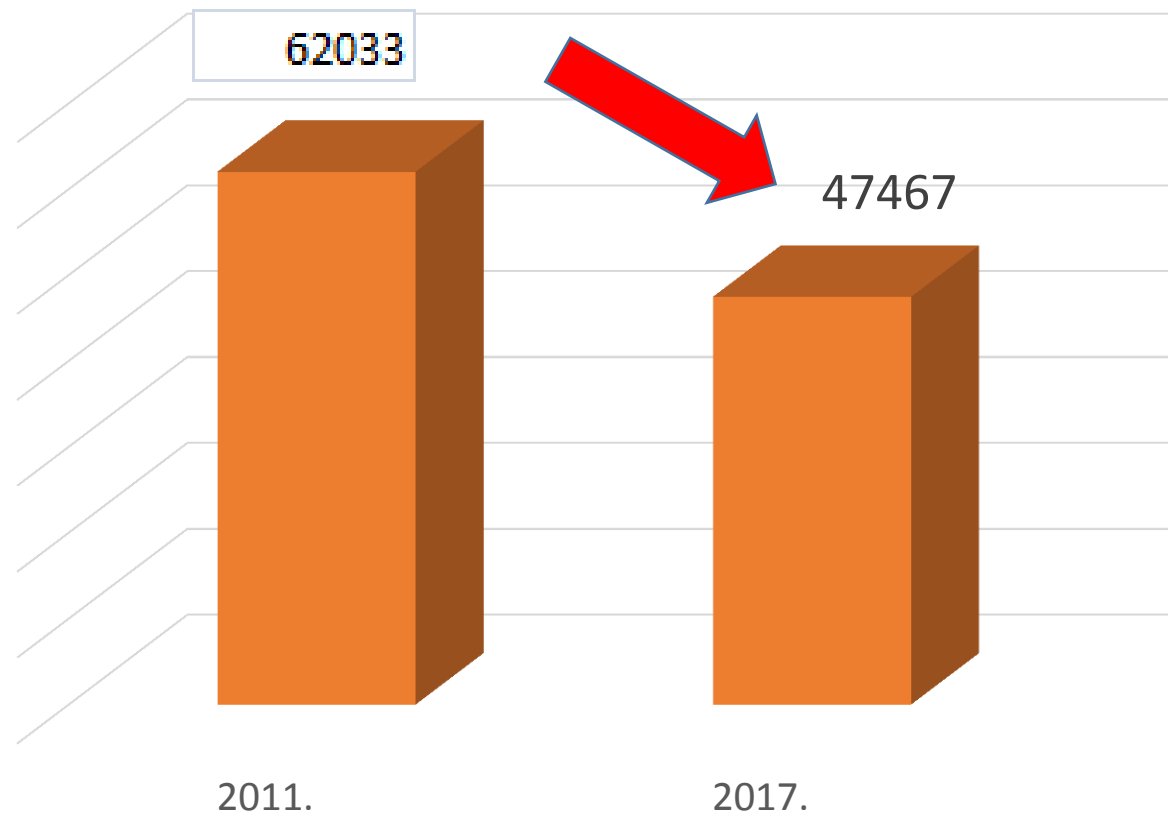
The number of prisoners in Russia (thousands)

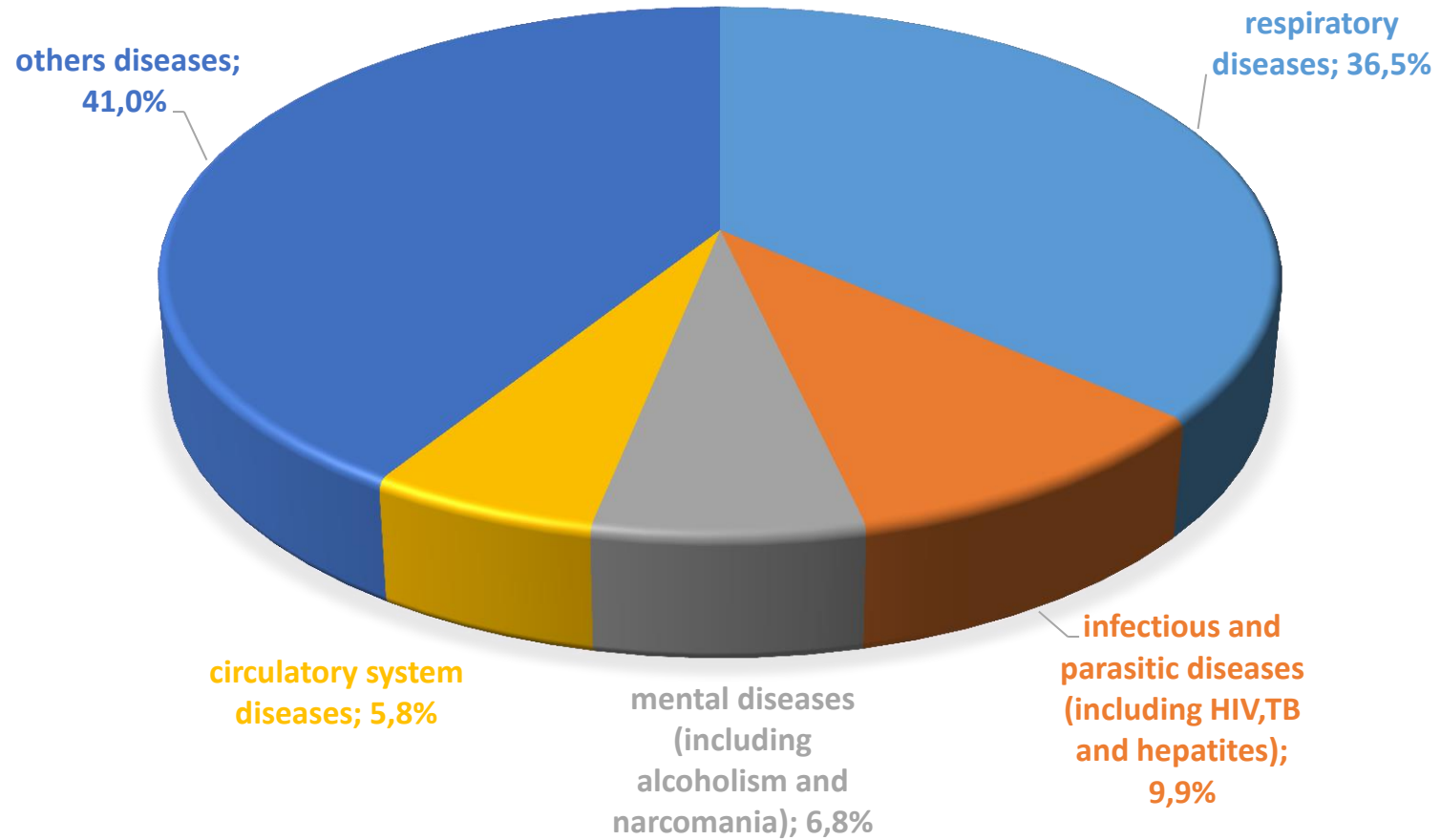

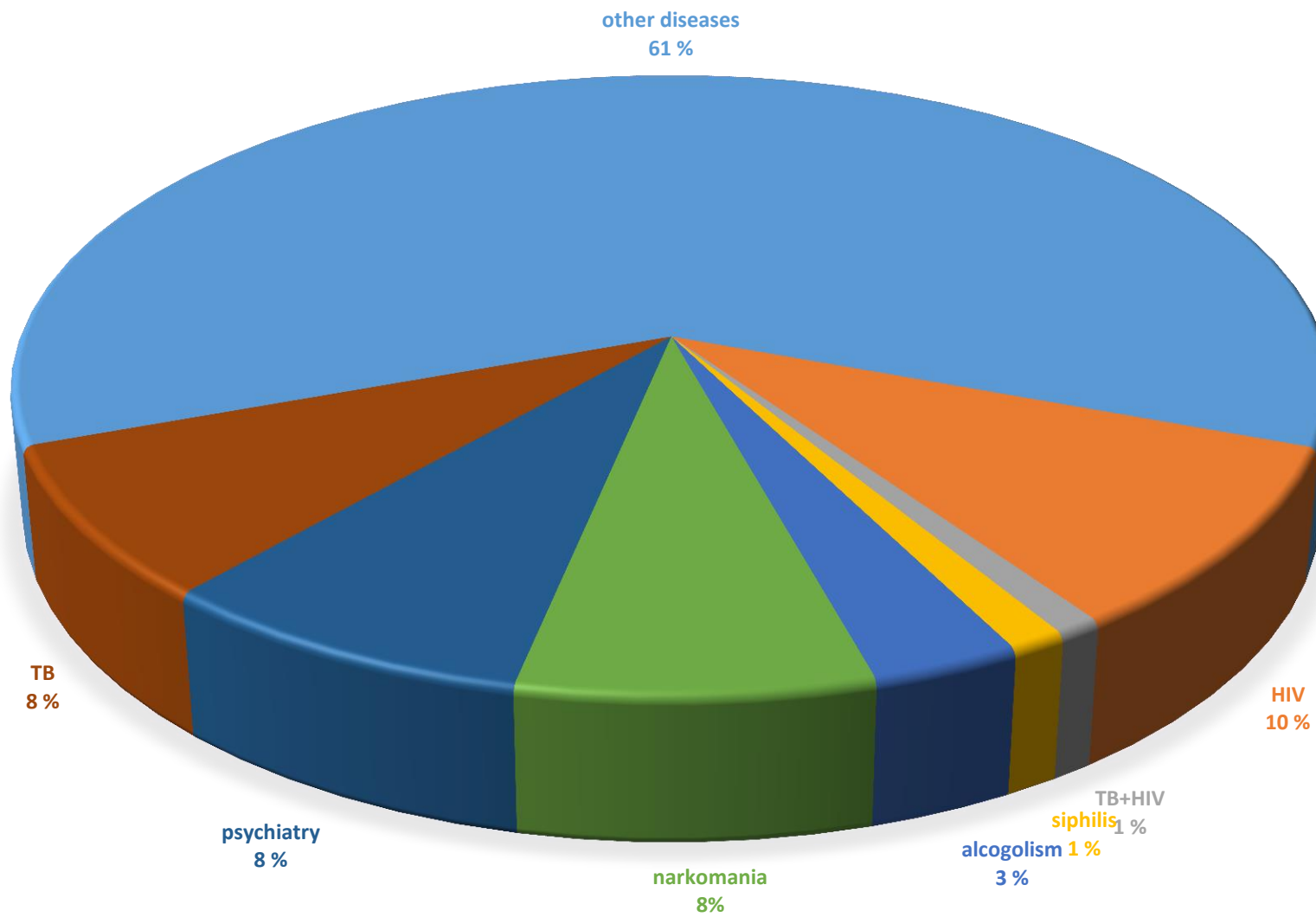

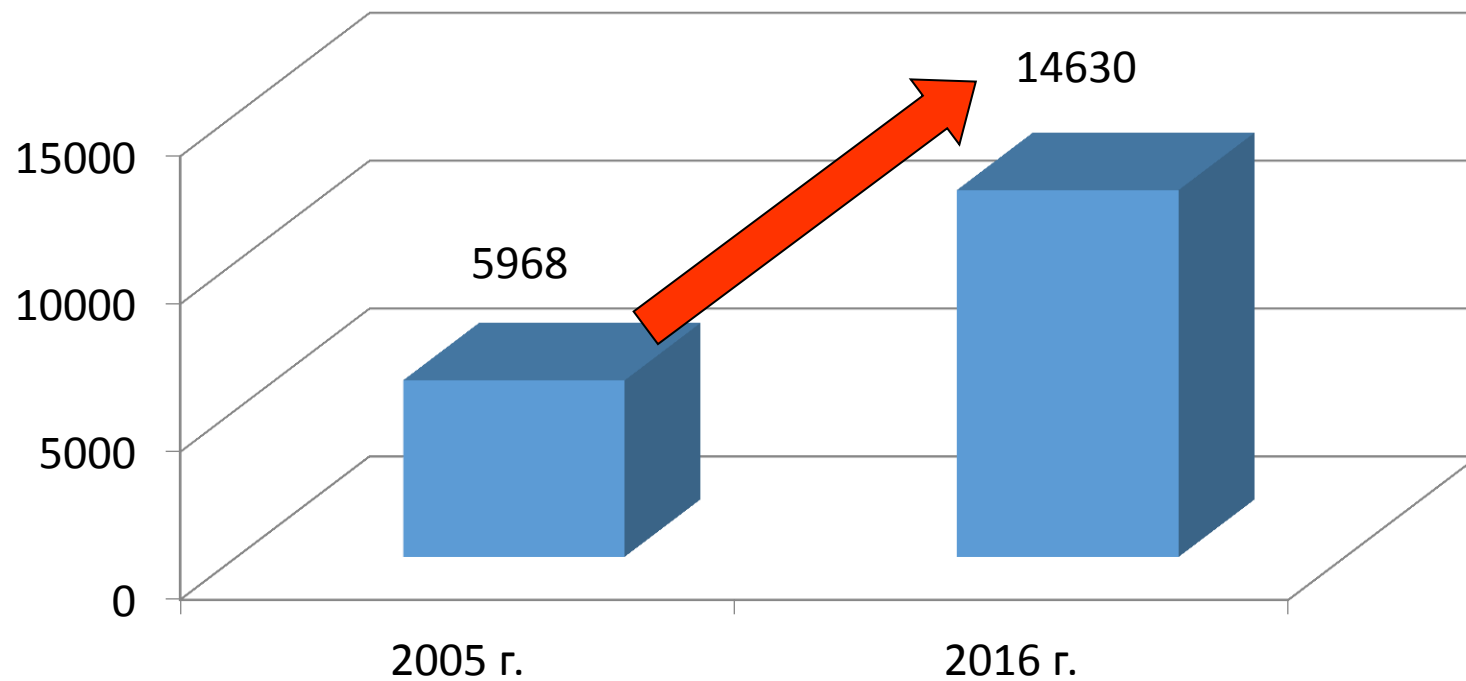


morbidity structure in prisoners (inew cases)

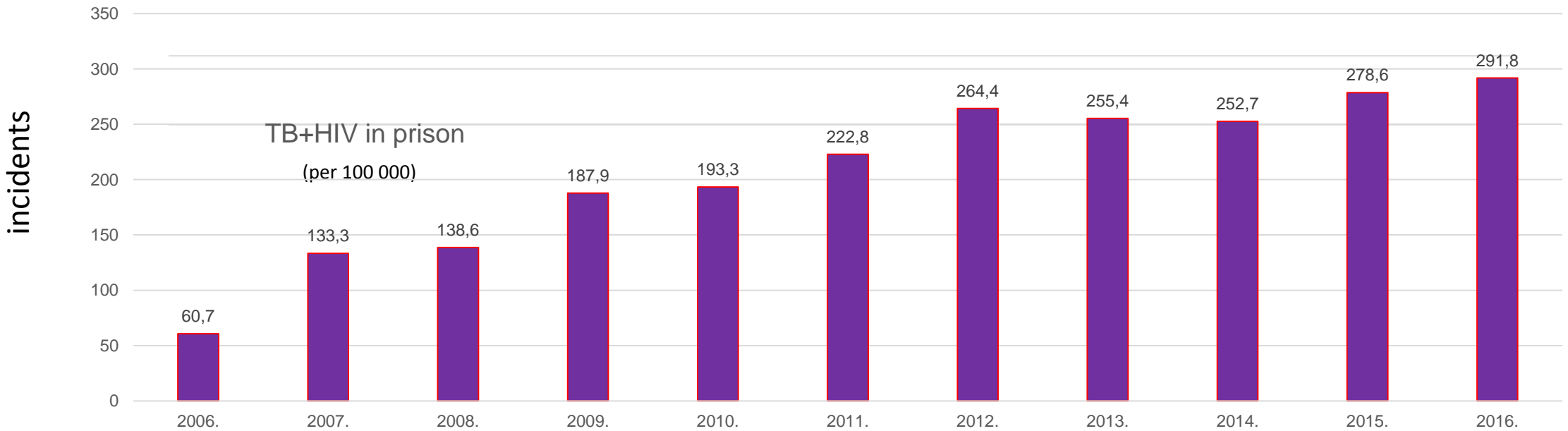
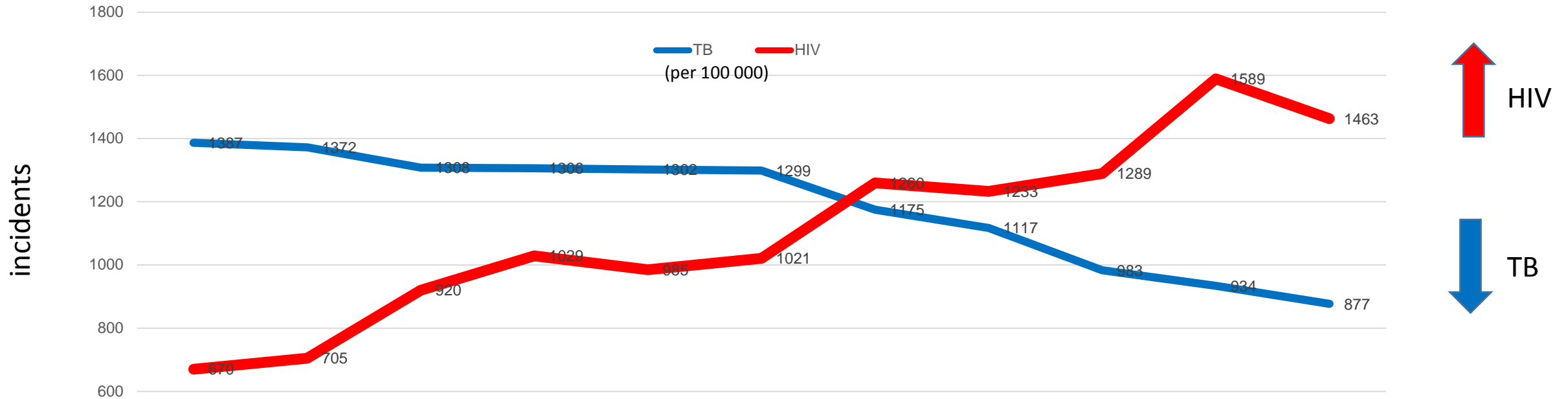


morbidity structure in prisoners (prevalence)

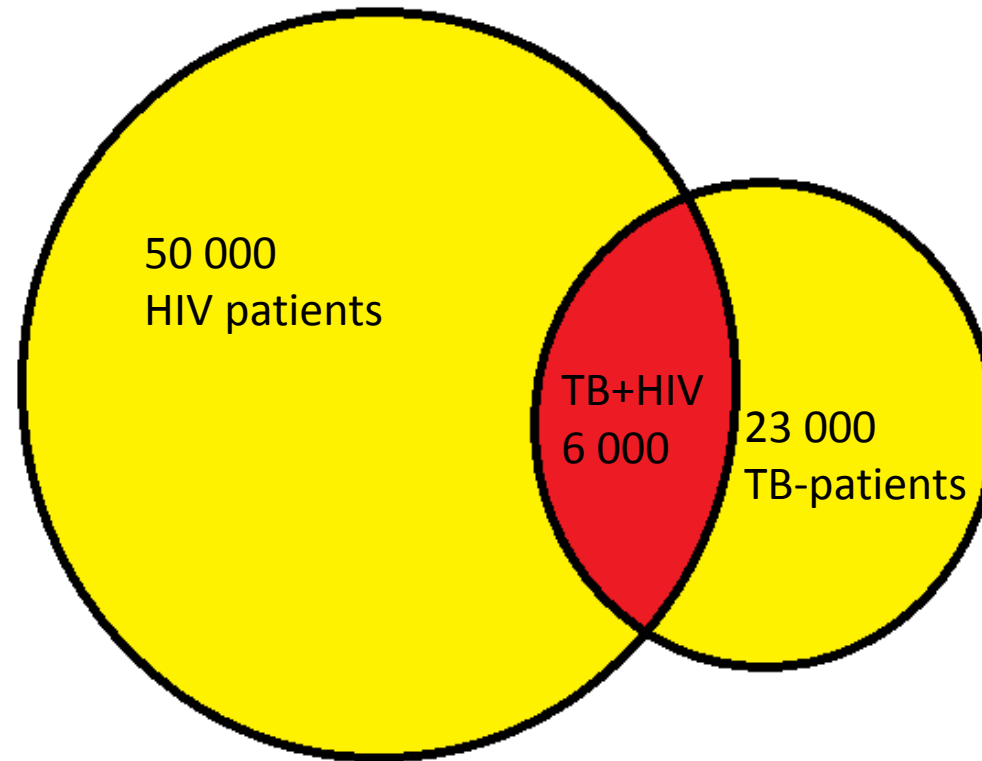


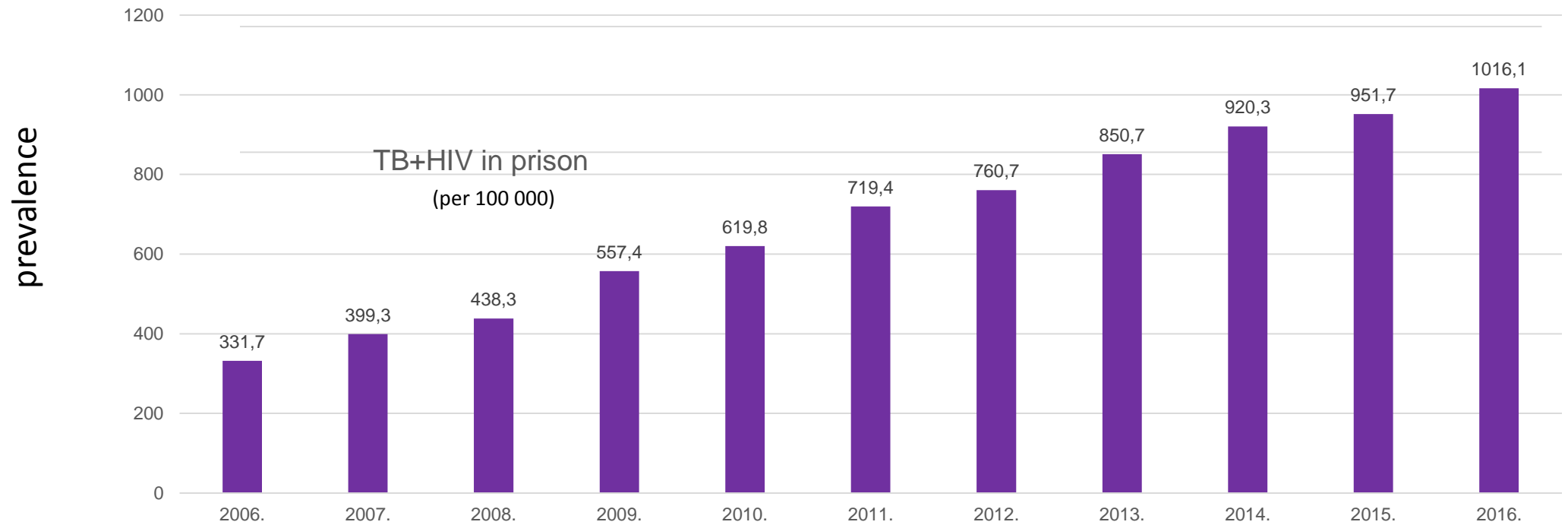
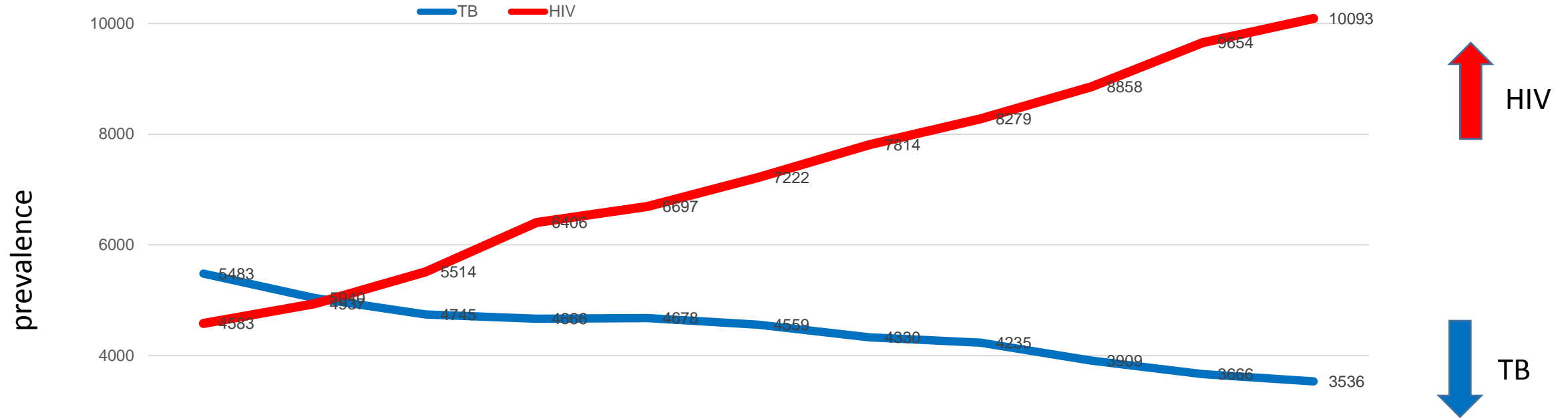


The number of newly diagnosed HIV-infected people among prisoners increased more than twice in 10 years

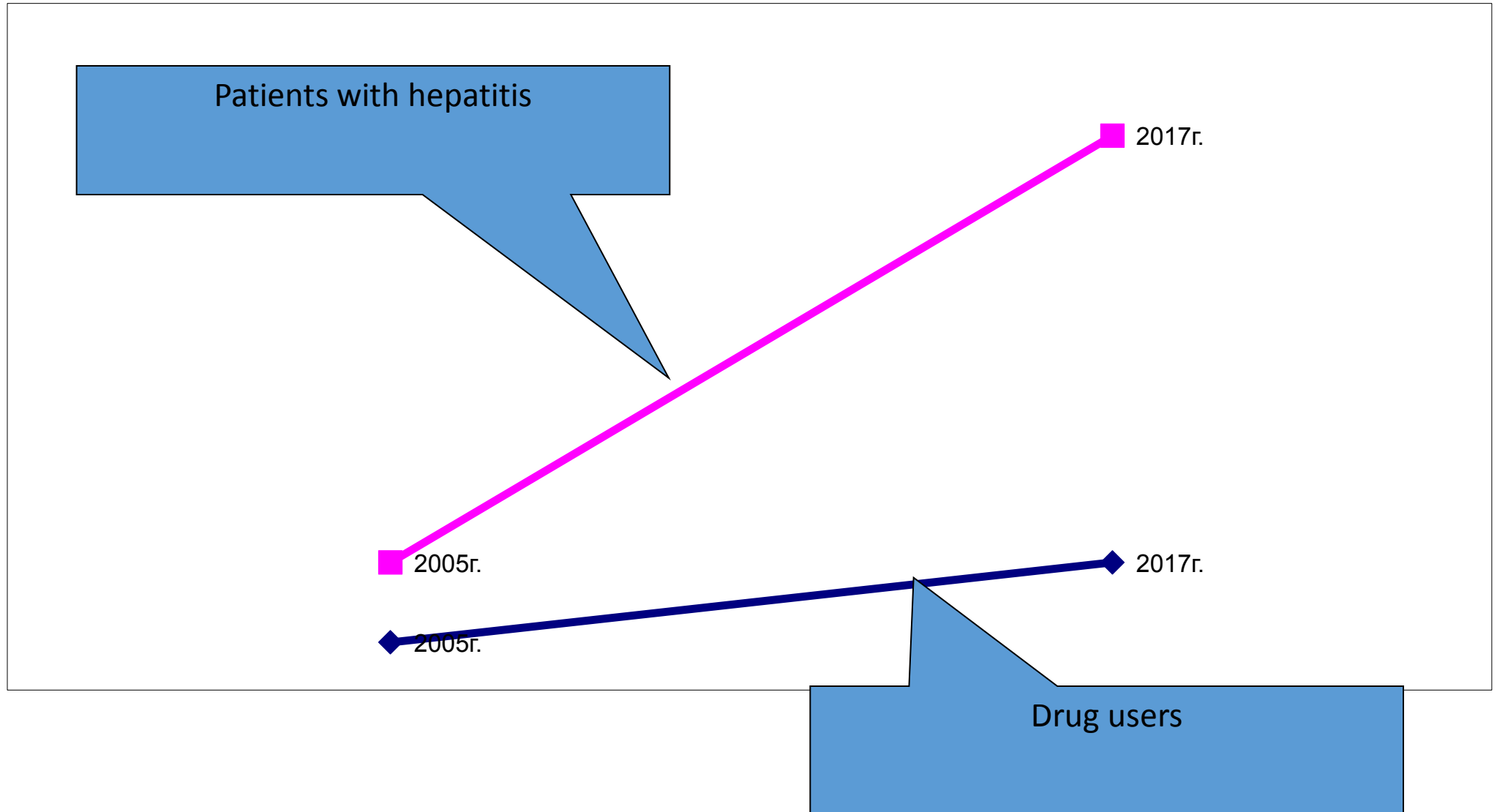


In the penitentiary system contained nearly 56,000 people with HIV and nearly 29,000 with tuberculosis. Most of these people are persons with co-infection "tuberculosis + HIV".





The increase in the number of people infected with HIV can be connected to an increase in the number of people with drug addiction (from 2005 to 2017, an increase in 1.5 times), and an increase of viral hepatitis (in 10 years from 2005 to 2017, the increase of almost in 5 times).



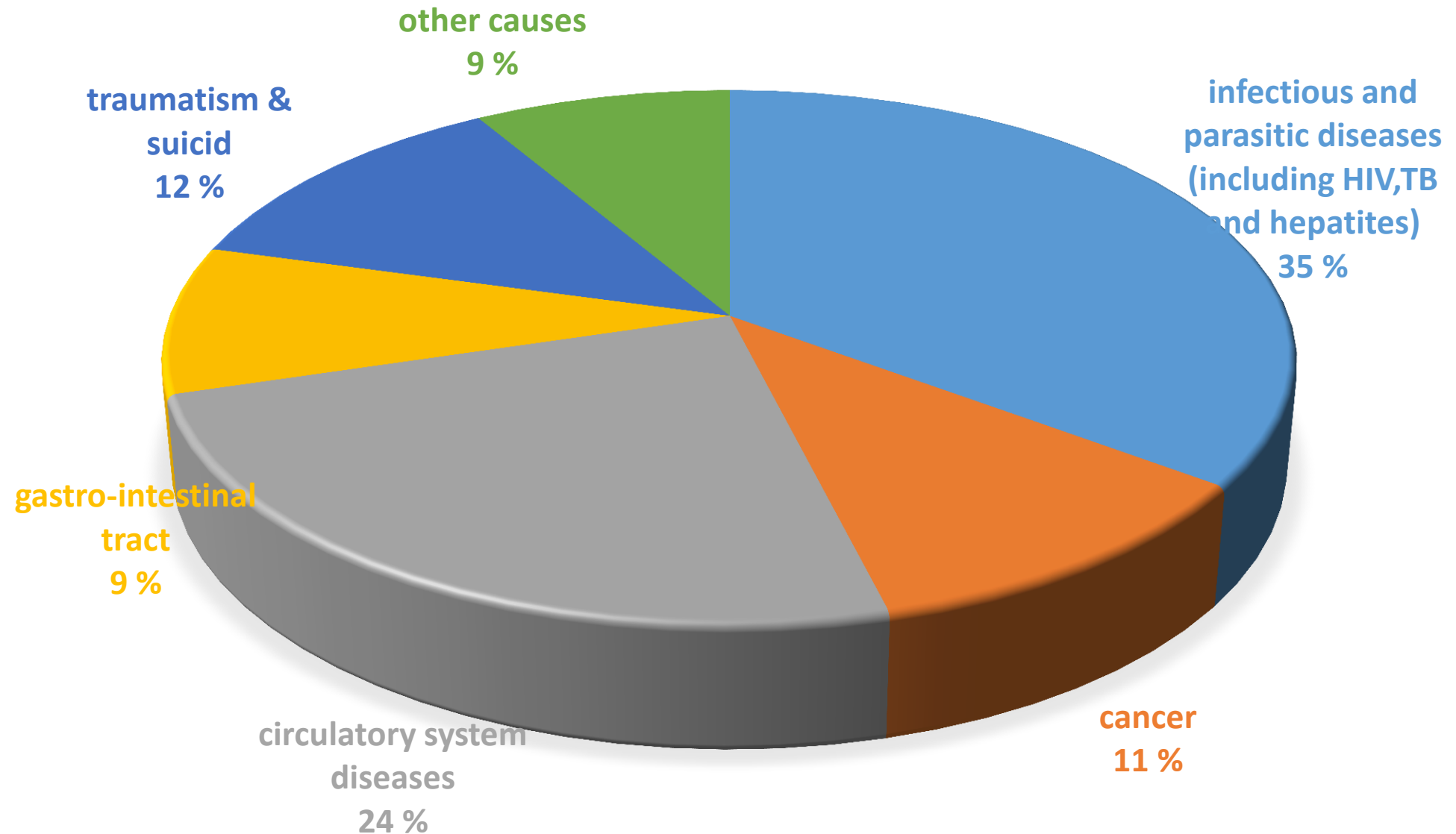

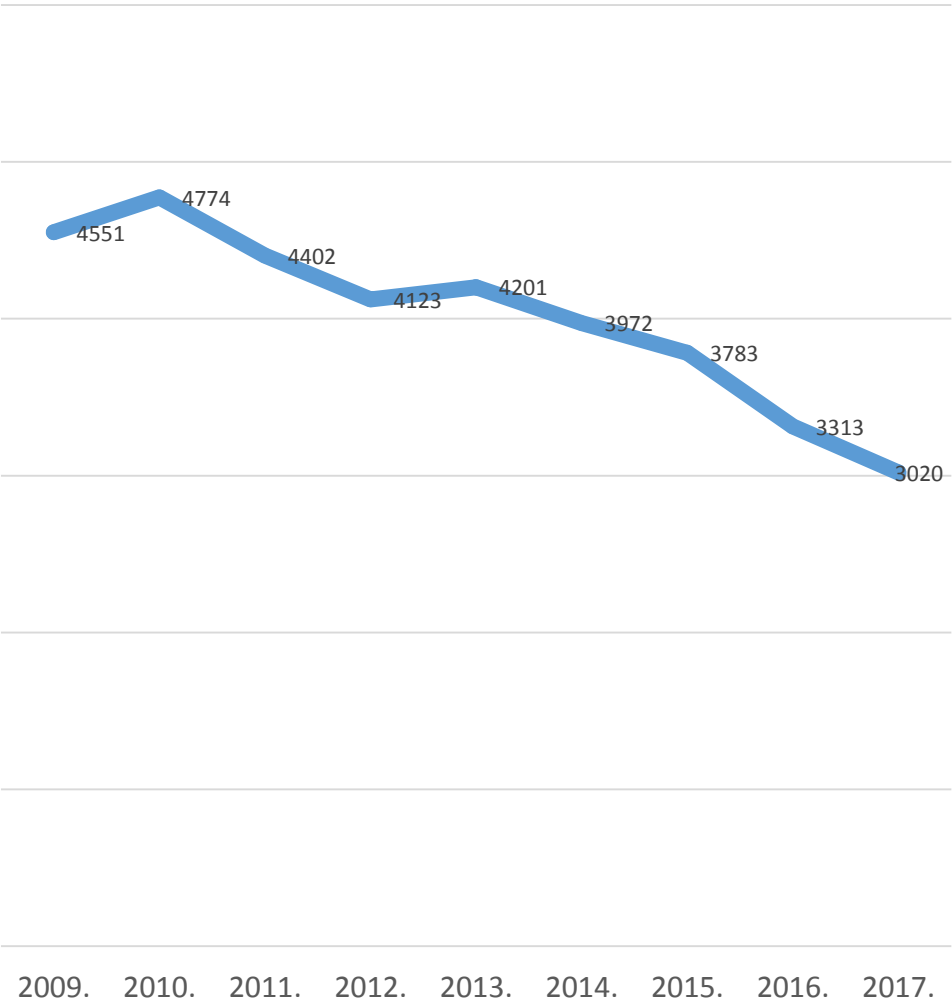
