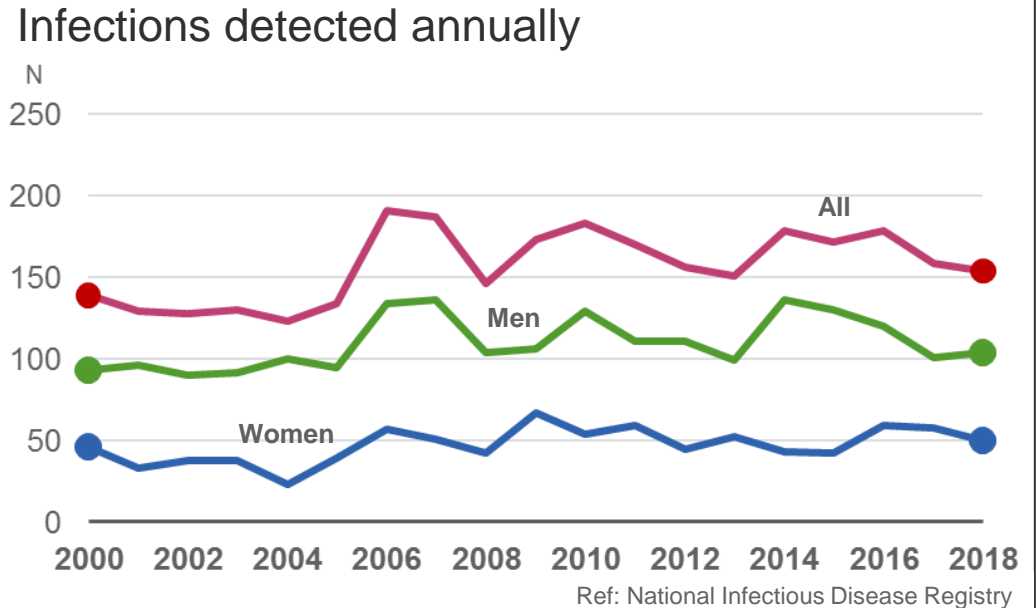

  - live 3516

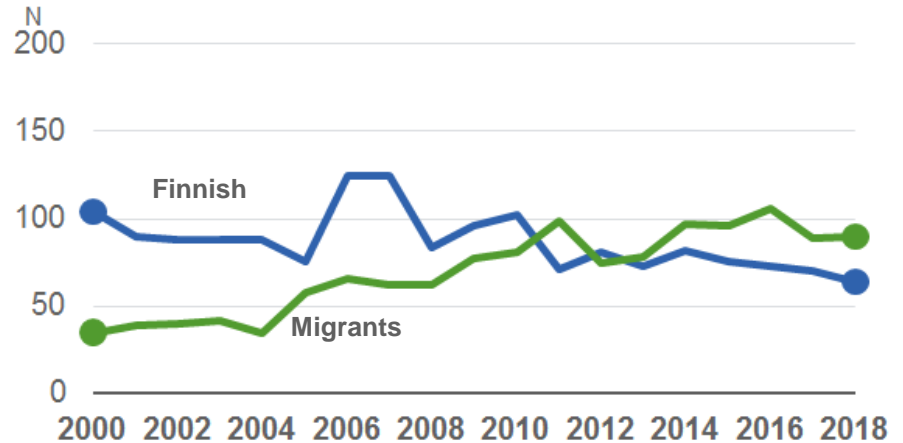


# THE MAJORITY OF INFECTIONS ARE FOREIGN ORIGIN

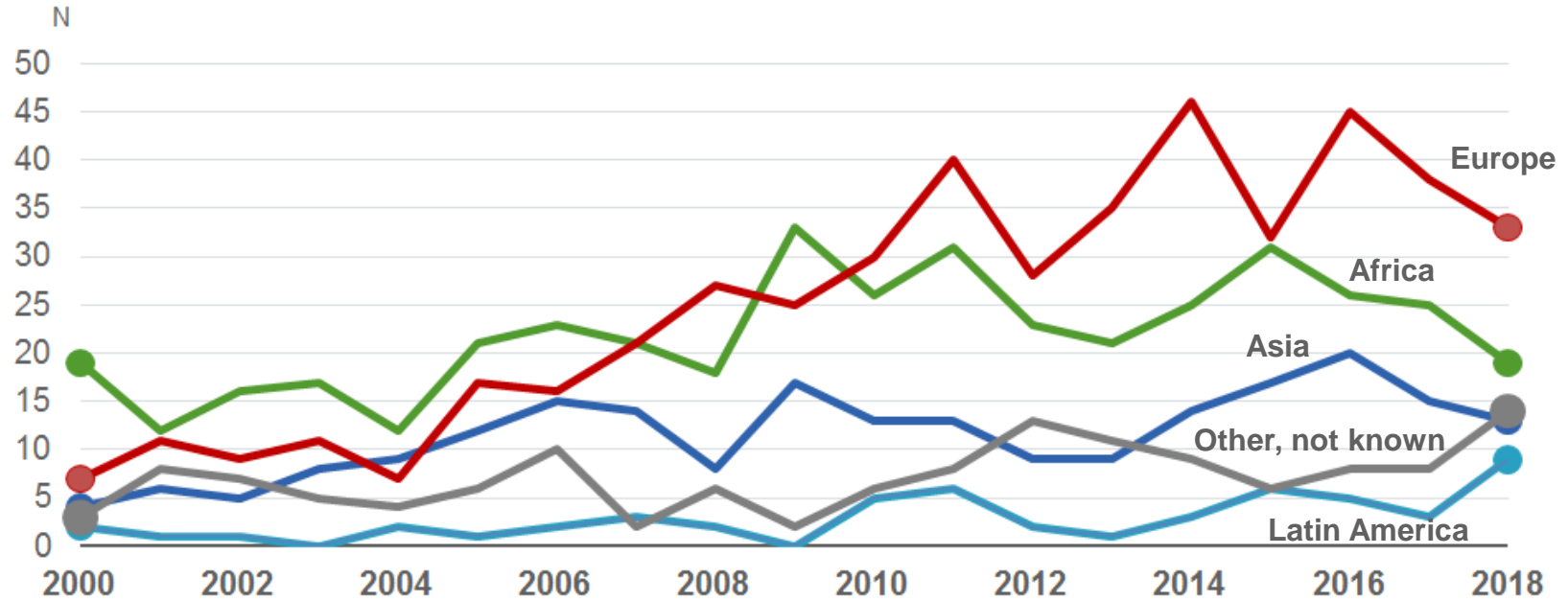

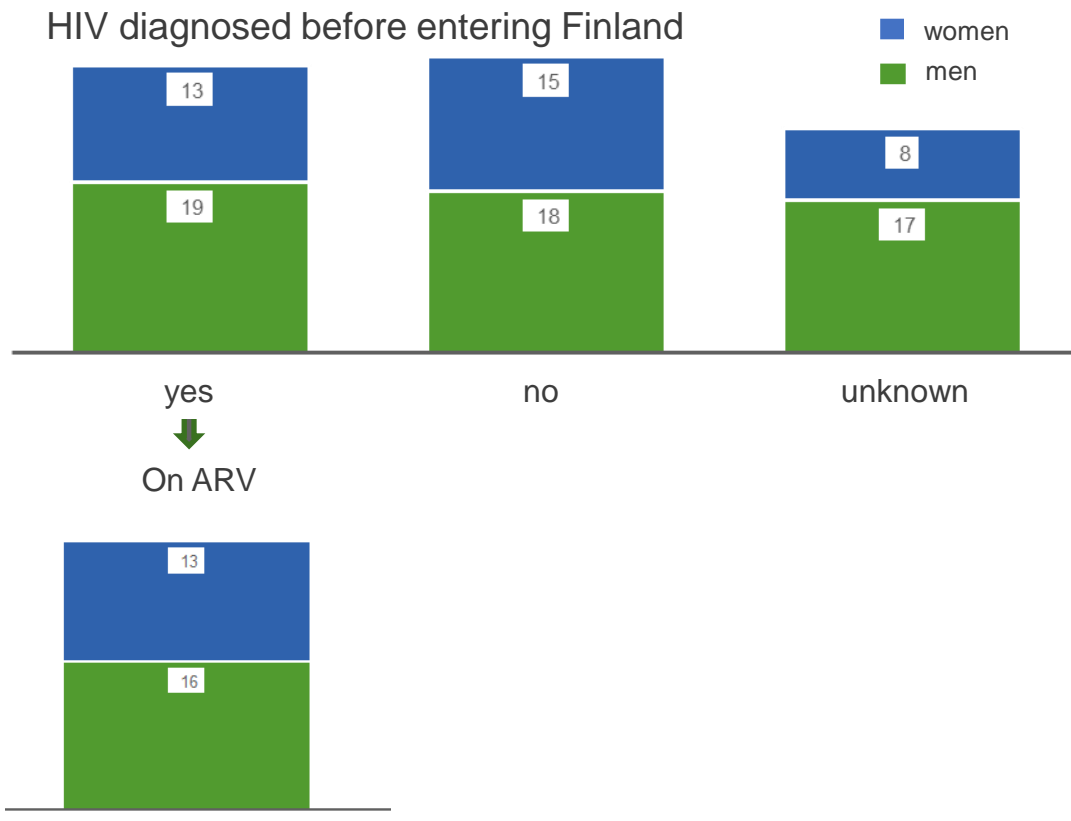

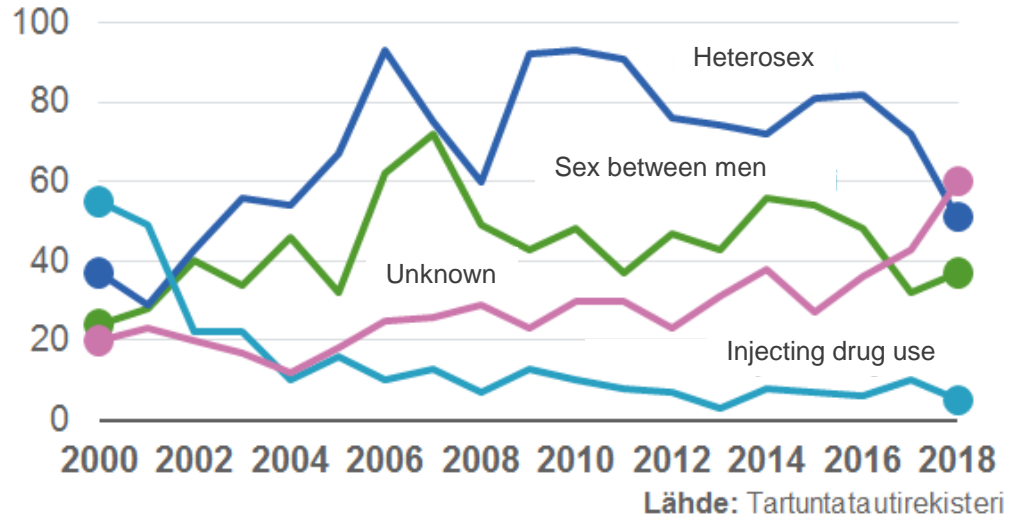


# HIV IS A SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASE IN FINLAND

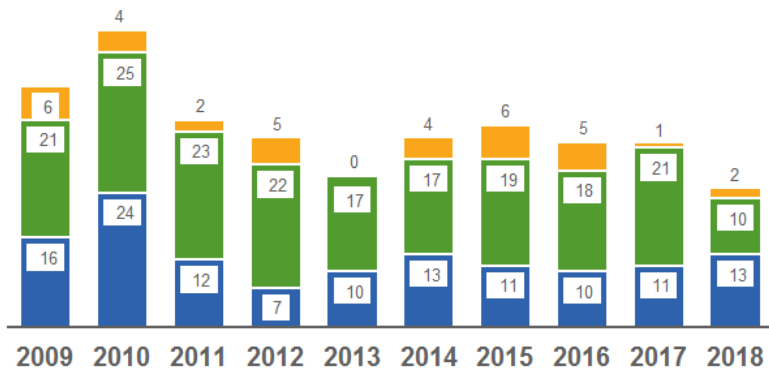

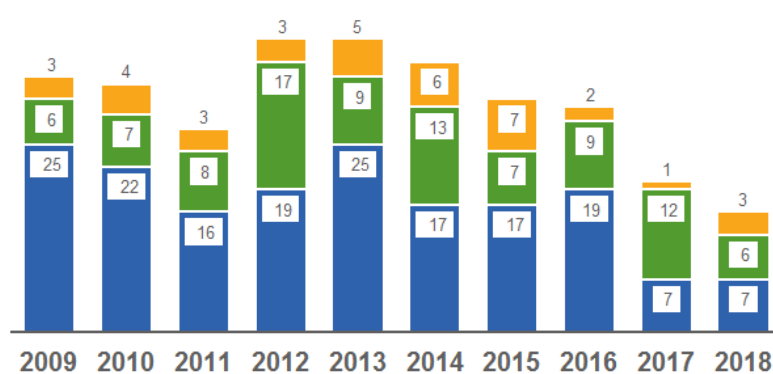


# HIGH PROPORTION OF INFECTIONS IN FINNISH PEOPLE CONTRACTED ABROAD

Finnish, heterosex



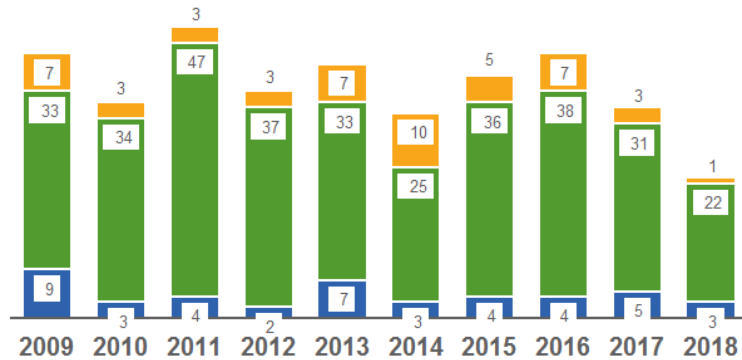
Finnish, sex between men



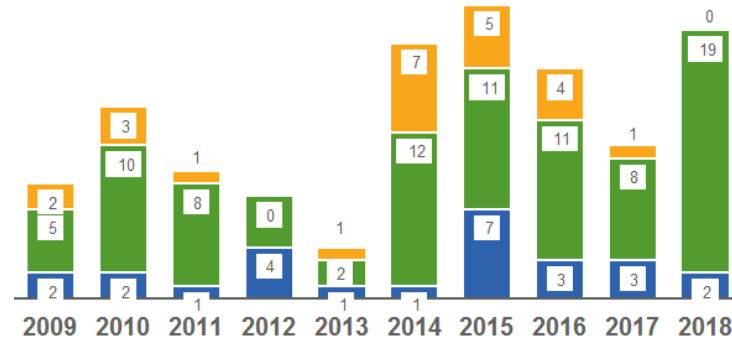

Migrants, sex between men

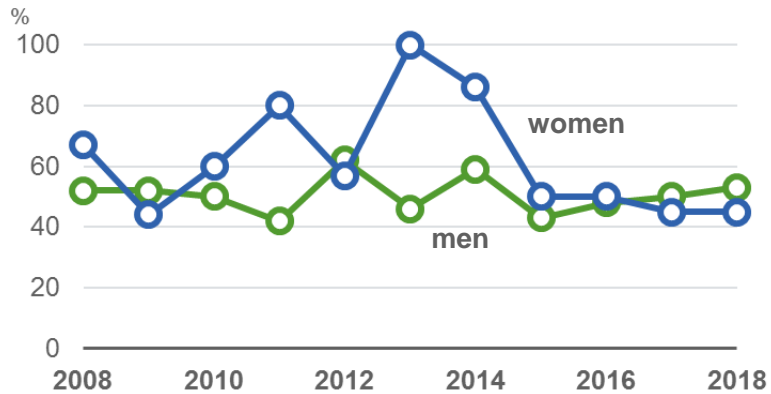

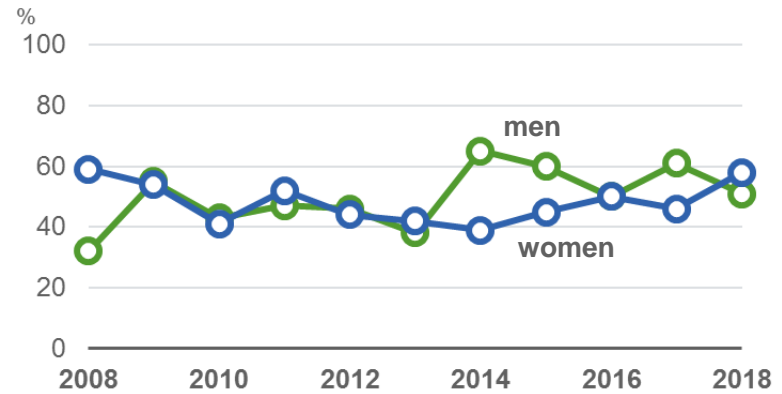
